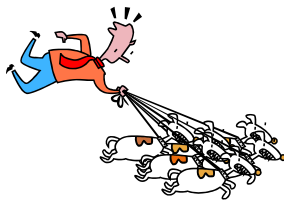

A Word of Caution to Pet Owners

Earlier this week, a white van with the words “Tri-County Animal Control” was spotted in Sevier County. However, no animal agency has that name, and the Sevier County animal control officer was not in the field that day.

Jayne Vaughn, Executive Director of the Sevier County Humane Society, worries that the drivers intended to steal companion animals, perhaps to sell for research or to use in illegal fighting.

This story is another reminder that the safest place for dogs and cats is indoors under lock and key. Don't risk their safety.
