



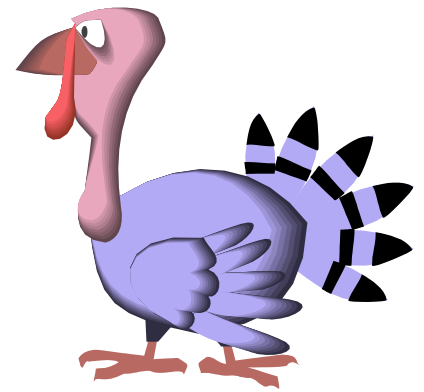

Music Soothes the Savage...Bunny?

A very big thanks to those of you who continue to help the animals in special ways. Cardboard litter trays, unfolded newspapers, cardboard tubes stuffed with hay—we love them all! These are the unusual items are in greatest need right now.



- **Small radios:** Studies have shown that classical music can alleviate some of the stress that shelter animals feel. 20 rooms in our new facility have animals in them. That's 20 radios.
- **Small boxes:** Within five days of entering a shelter, dogs begin to adjust and relax. It takes cats five weeks. Many cats feel more secure when they hide in the back of the cage, and we'd like to make that happen. We need shoe boxes and other small boxes for our incoming cats. This will be an ongoing need.
- **Cat toys:** Put just a bit of loose catnip in a child's sock, tie the sock in a knot, and your toy is ready to go!
- **Stuffed animals:** Our dogs are hard on their soft toys, but we love to watch them have a ball! Please clean out your toy boxes, keep an eye out at yard sales and at thrift stores, and make our dogs happy!
